1. What motivates you to volunteer?

4. What types of unforeseen problems, difficult challenges, or stressful situations have you experienced in your life? How did you handle them?
5. Describe a time when you experienced a conflict with another person or group of people. How did you handle or resolve the situation?
6. What experiences have you had in other countries or with people of different nationalities or cultures? What challenges and difficulties do you expect to encounter living in a foreign culture with a different set of values?
7. What is your idea of community? Describe any experiences you have had living in community.
8. How do you recognize and fulfill your personal, spiritual and emotional needs? How do you take care of yourself?
9. Are you particular about cleanliness or diet?
10. Are you aware of the opportunities to serve in the Trujillo volunteer community and adolescent homes? If so, what are your thoughts on living and serving outside of the main Farm community? On living in community with Honduran adolescents and house staff?
11. If you enjoy volunteering at the Farm, how long might you wish to stay? What are your plans after volunteering?
